i've just read Charles' post regarding this issue. on facebook. I've pondered this very question for some time. call it a 'Pet' theory.

I Suggest; as feasibility goes; a 'Main' line down the 'Frenchtown' 'corridor' from Brownsville could, given the 1000 ft. of dynamic 'head', might deliver through a 18" Sch 40 Main, could gravity flow, as much as 18,000 gpm. At 1700 ft. elevation at OH.

using A "Ram" pump, a lesser, but, substantial amount of water could be, further, pumped up into storage in the dixon hill / Candlewood area.
of course, at a slower rate.

additional storage in these areas would be required. if NYWD is willing, all's the better.

Given the rate of household wells failing in the DOH area, extension of domestic water in the area is a win Win! I sense that public support is easily enough Developed.

With 10,000 Gpm, and 1000ft dynamic head, we arrive at, some, 60, 000 ft lbs. of energy. A larger main nets greater Energy.

My numbers, are 'back of the Napkin' calcs, but, further Analysis might justify a more extensive analysis.. good old Newton'S F=MA. I suggest a phased effort, over time might pass budget Scrutiny.


