Dear Charles,

Thank you for your request. Unfortunately, your request (copy attached) needs to be clear and specific and, in its current form, is not a complete valid request. Additionally, there are no reports, as I believe you are looking for. All public reports are created through the below mentioned platforms AFTER incident data from various sources (FD, ECC, SD, PD, etc.) is compiled, vetted, validated, and screened for any privacy concerns.

I do, however, believe I understand the nature of your request and believe you are trying to determine response times. Our Fire Department operates under the umbrella of CalFire and all incident reporting and record keeping is done through CalFire and associated repository platforms. If I understand what you are looking for, the best way to do this is to go to the data repositories and record keeping agency(s) our Fire Department submits all incident data to for validation, compilation, and storage.

Please understand, specific incident information is not public until it has been validated by the relevant CalFire-associated platform. This is due to various HIPAA and other privacy rules.
